Pre-Access Declaration

By signing above I confirm I understand that:-

1. Official fixed aids have a DYOCAP tag and are listed on the website at www.dyo.org.uk. Though installed, inspected and maintained by experienced cavers, aids should be carefully checked before use. Cavers use these fixed aids at their own risk and are strongly advised to use additional safety measures, such as lifelines or cows' tails, wherever possible. Any signs of wear or damage to fixed aids are to be reported to the Panel immediately after the trip via the trip report form on the website. Any other ropes, ladders or aids found in the cave are unofficial and should not be used.
2. **Completing this form is not an arrangement for rescue callout.**
3. **The warden is personally responsible for checking all members of the party are insured as cavers under the BCA scheme. BCA insurance numbers of each caver must be entered on the form.**

Notes on completing this form

1. This form is to be checked by the warden. **Before entering the cave it must be handed into the ticket office or inserted into the ticket office counter slot when the office is closed. The post box on the back wall of the ticket office is no longer to be used.**
2. Access to Dan yr Ogof is granted subject to the rules published on the DYOCAP website.
3. It is the Warden's responsibility to ensure that all members of the party are covered by BCA insurance. This is best achieved by sight of a current BCA membership card and entering the card number on the form. Firm evidence of current membership of a BCA-insured club is an acceptable alternative but please ensure that the club name is entered clearly.
4. Parties must make their own arrangements for callout in case they become overdue – for example by using the trip board at South Wales Caving Club.
5. A dragon logo must be left in the windscreen of all cavers' cars prior to entering the cave.
